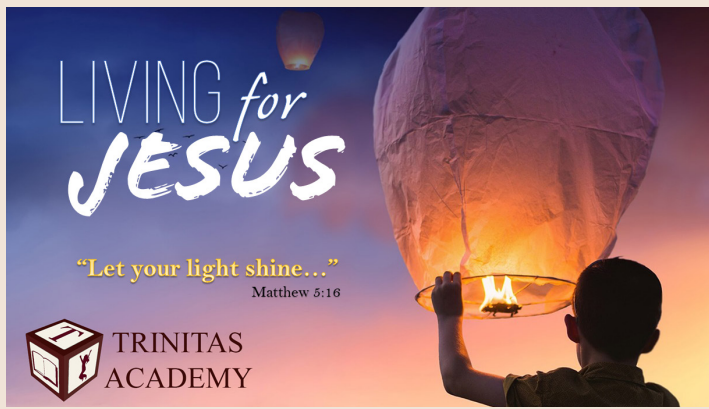

LIVING FOR JESUS MEANS PLACING OUR TRUST IN HIM

Take Courage: Overcoming fear begins with strength, but not our own. We must look to the One who encourages us to be strong. Trust in the Lord: Peter's trust was complete when he stepped onto the water, knowing that only the Lord could make the impossible happen.

Trust in His Word: We, too, need to recognize that Jesus is calling us to conquer our fears through trust in His Word.

However, as Peter took his eyes off Jesus and focused on the storm, he became afraid and began to sink. He cried out for the Lord's salvation, which was immediately extended to him. This episode illustrates the importance of unwavering faith and trust in Christ. Even Jesus faced temptations rooted in fear but remained sinless by fully trusting His Father. As Hebrews 4:15 tells us, *"For we do not have a High Priest who cannot be touched with the feelings of our infirmities, but was in all points tempted as we are, yet without sin."*

Whenever fear creeps into our hearts, we can turn to God in prayer, seeking refuge and strength in Him. We can echo the words of Psalms 56:3-4: "Whenever I am afraid, I will trust in You. In God, I will praise His word; in God, I have put my trust; I will not fear."

"Dear Heavenly Father, grant us the grace to navigate this year with the strength that comes from You. I pray for all the families of Trinitas Academy, that we would all experience Your love for us in a special way as You help us to overcome our fears. Thank You for the courage to live for You in this world with so many fears. Thank You for Your promise that You will never leave us or forsake us. In Jesus' name, Amen."

The theme for this school year at Trinitas Academy is **"Living for Jesus."** As students and staff, we find ourselves grappling with a common challenge: how to place our daily trust in Christ when confronted with our fears.

Fear is a universal emotion that all of us share, especially as parents in these uncertain times. We fear for our children's well-being, worrying about sickness, death, scarcity, and the unknown future. However, we firmly believe that Jesus can and has empowered us to conquer these fears, and we take solace in the fact that He is present today to assist us in our journey. In Psalms 23:4, it is written: *"Even though I walk through the darkest valley, I will fear no evil, for you are with me; your rod and your staff, they comfort me."*

This verse reminds us that despite the challenges we face, we can find comfort and courage in Christ.

Fear can often manifest as phobias, which originate from the Greek word "phobos." Phobias are irrational fears of things that pose little or no actual danger. There exists a vast array of fears, each representing a legion of fears. It is important to note that not all fears are wrong; like a child's fear of a hot stove, is entirely justified because it protects us from harm. Similarly, it is right for us to fear sin and Satan, as they can bring about devastation in our lives. Fortunately, the Word of God provides us with valuable lessons to overcome our fears, such as the account of Peter walking on water in Matthew 14:22-33. Here are the key lessons from Peter's experience:
