

# WHO ARE YOU?


For God, who said, "Let light shine out of darkness," has shone in our hearts to give the light of the knowledge of the glory of God in the face of Jesus Christ. - 2 Corinthians 4:6

As you live for Jesus, it is important to know who Jesus is, but also who you are. And only the light of the glory of Christ can shine the light of truth in us. We live in a world where our students are being stripped of

anything that might give them identity and purpose. Without getting into the craziness of our society that suggests God can make a mistake in giving us our identity, we need to help our students find "their place in this world". First, there is a God and you're not Him. There is Creator who made all things and sustains all things. Second, He created us with the capacity to relate to Him and with a specific identity from the very beginning.

He created humans, male and female. Third, all was very good, until sin entered the world because man thought they were better at determining what is right and wrong, rather than God being the standard for what is good. Sin now gets in the way and keeps us disoriented in why we are here and for what. Fourth, in the same way that God created the world and spoke light into darkness, it is only the light of Christ that shines into the darkness of our world and hearts. Yes, we are sinners, but thanks to the life, death, and resurrection of Christ, our existence is brought into perspective. In Christ, we realize we were created to live for the one who made us. and to carry out His purpose for our lives: to know Him and make Him known. It is our own sin that keeps us from knowing Him and ourselves. But when we believe in Christ as Savior and Lord, our sins are forgiven, and our relationship with God restored. When we know we are His, because He has made us His, we can live our lives for Jesus!
