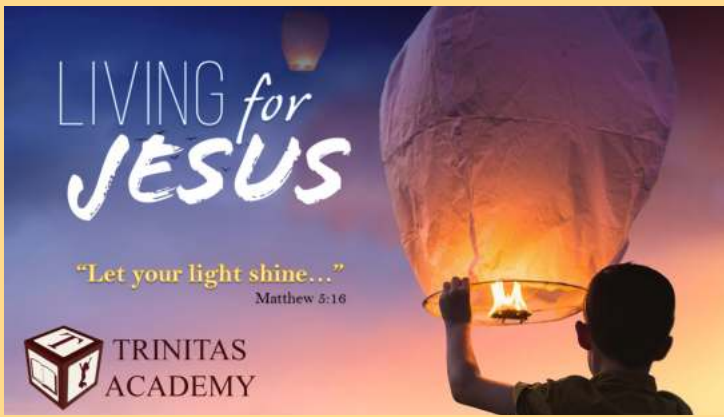

He created humans, male and female.
